For example, GE's new GeoSpring hot water heater operates with a dual energy source, using a heat pump to maintain water temperature and switching to electric heat only when there is a rise in demand. It uses less than half of the energy required by traditional electric water heaters."

"There is now available a dual fuel range, with a gas cooktop and an electric oven," Zagar continued. "It has the new European style convention oven with a third heating element and a reversing fan that provides even baking without having to turn the dish during cooking. There are also new insulation products and many other new items that can be included. When we build a custom home, the answer to our customers' wishes is 'yes, you can."

Florida Lifestyle Homes has answered many of its clients' more personal custom requests, in one home including a high-definition golf simulator in the game room.

"We added a private outdoor shower in an enclosed garden area just outside the master suite for one client," said Randy Frederick, consultant with Florida Lifestyle Homes. "Another requested a built-in organic herb garden that automatically provides the optimal light and water to the plants. We have built 'safe rooms' in some homes. We included a special sink in the laundry room closet for one client who wanted to use it to wash her dogs. They ask; we deliver."
